#### **OUR VISION AND MISSION - NEW BUSINESS**

- Youth and Family Position -Jill has submitted her letter of resignation and will work with the reach program at the school

  - o Pastor Nate proposed \$17-18 pay for the interim position
  - Hold off on Youth and Family position at this time Pastor Nate can take the lead on some of this at this time

- The committee extends an interim position to Jill through the end of July 2022 to assist with the Youth Gathering for 5-10 hours weekly at a rate of \$18. A motion is made by Sara Stone, this is seconded by Tracy Church. Motion carried.
- COVID plan for the fall: plan to move to as much of our normal scheduling and opportunities as able, just be prepared to act in response to COVID. Be supportive of our schools and our medical community.
