- August/Early September Highlights
 - 1. Busy getting ready for fall. Have confirmation mapped out for the year, along with 6 adult mentors. We should have around 30 students in grades 7-9.
 - 2. I have been grateful for the faithful few who have been serving in worship as ushers, lectors, coffee servers, and helping set up communion. I have hope that fall will bring greater participation.
- Looking Ahead:
 - 1. Looking forward to Wednesday worship. I have a small band organized to lead each week. And I think the stuff Pastor Megan is organizing to go with that will be really great. Encourage council to get involved.
 - 2. 10th grade confirmation will be a challenge for us. Date is Reformation Sunday (October 31). We have around 20 kids affirming their faith. The faith statement stuff will go well. But that's a lot of people for a service. And probably 50% or more will be unvaccinated. Will be working with 10th grade families September 22 to figure this out.
 - 3. Launching a podcast Pastor Megan and Pastor Nate "You gotta try this" Faith practices, discipleship practices try them in your home and life. First one will be on meal time faith practices interview with the Ross family. October will be on feeding ministries and November on the giving tree.
 - 4. I am hoping to offer an online Bible/Discipleship study in some form this year. Maybe an October start for that? Would appreciate feedback from the council on topics, as well as days and times.
 - 5. There is most certainly a COVID wave coming. What is our plan?

Associate Pastor: Pastor Megan Clapp

- Getting ready for the education year excited to gear back up again
 - New this year will be intergenerational service projects and bible study once per month
 - Ideally would like to add in age groups but right now we don't have volunteers to make that possible
 - Focus for worship messages is on faith practices at home around times: mealtime, bedtime, drive time, morning time

- Back to school milestone and blessings are happening this Sunday 9/12 and Wednesday 9/15
- Wed Sept 22nd bible milestones for 3-year-olds and 3rd graders
- We will be introducing an updated version of the Parent Cue App that will be used more this year with households with children
